I am the Director of Legal Notice for Eisner Advisory Group, LLC 16 ("EisnerAmper"), a full-service administration firm providing legal administration services, 17 including the design, development, and implementation of unbiased complex legal notification 18 programs. 19 In the Declaration of Brandon Schwartz in Regarding the Proposed Notice Plan 2 20 and Settlement Administration ("Schwartz Decl.") filed on September 13, 2024, and submitted 21 along with my C.V., I detailed the proposed Notice Plan to administer the claims process in the above-referenced matter (the "Action")1. combination of (1) email notice; (2) digital banner and social media notice; (3) a Settlement Website; and (4) a toll-free hotline.

- 3. On September 19, 2024, Judge Lee approved the Notice Plan, related notice forms, and appointed EisnerAmper as the Settlement Administrator in the *Order Granting Plaintiff's Unopposed Motion for Preliminary Approval* ("Preliminary Approval Order"). Preliminary Approval Order ¶¶ 2–3, and 7.
- 4. In the Order, Judge Lee conditionally certified a Class defined as "[a]ll individuals who purchased a concession at Climate Pledge Arena between February 27, 2023 and July 22, 2023 and were assessed a 3% fee. Excluded from the Settlement Class are: (i) Defendant and its officers and directors; (ii) all Settlement Class Members who timely and validly submit requests for exclusion from the Settlement Class; (iii) members of the judiciary to whom this case is assigned, their families, and members of their staff."
- 5. Beginning on October 17, 2024, EisnerAmper began to implement the Notice Plan in accordance with its requirements. This declaration will discuss the implementation of the Notice Plan and Settlement Administration

NOTICE PLAN SUMMARY

Direct Email Notice

- 6. On October 3, 2024, EisnerAmper received a file containing the Ticket Purchaser List (collectively the "Class Notice List") that included the names and email address for a total of 144,341 records. After reviewing and deduplicating the data, EisnerAmper determined that a total of 125,850 unique records existed which contained 124,564 facially valid email addresses. Individual notice was attempted to all on the Class Notice list for whom a facially valid email address was provided.
- 7. Beginning on October 17, 2024, EisnerAmper sent the Email Notice to the 124,564 facially valid email addresses on the Class Notice List. Ultimately, the Email Notice was successfully delivered to 123,936 email addresses, or 99.49% deliverability. A true and correct

copy of the Email Notice is attached hereto as **Exhibit A**. Email notice delivery statistics are detailed in Table 1 below.

Digital Advertising Notice

8. Pursuant to the Order, and beginning on October 17, 2024, EisnerAmper caused digital banner notices to run across a network of sites as well as the social media sites Facebook, and Instagram. Digital notices were targeted to individuals in accordance with the Schwartz Decl. (¶16) and allowed website visitors to identify themselves as potential Settlement Class Members and click through to the Settlement Website. More than 10,985,440 impressions were generated during the campaign, which was 590,440 more than described in the Schwartz Decl. Screenshots of the digital banner and video notices are attached as **Exhibit B**.

Settlement Website

9. On October 17, 2024, EisnerAmper took the Settlement Website, www.seattlearenafeesettlement.com, live. Visitors to the Settlement Website can download the Notices, the Claim Form, court documents such as: the *Amended Class Action Complaint*; *Unopposed Motion for Preliminary Approval*; *Preliminary Approval Order*; and the Settlement Agreement. Visitors were also able to electronically submit Claims, documentation, address updates, find answers to frequently asked questions ("FAQs"), important dates and deadlines, and contact information for the Settlement Administrator.

Dedicated Toll-Free Hotline

10. EisnerAmper also established the toll-free hotline, 1-844-871-5300, dedicated to this Settlement. The toll-free hotline is accessible 24 hours per day, seven days per week, and NOTICE PLAN AND SETTLEMENT ADMINISTRATION DECLARATION - 3

utilizes an interactive voice response (IVR) system where Settlement Class Members can obtain essential information regarding the Settlement and get responses to FAQs. Settlement Class Members have the option to leave a voicemail and receive a call back from the Settlement Administrator.

Email Support

11. EisnerAmper established the email address, info@seattlearenafeesettlement.com, to provide email support, allowing Settlement Class Members to direct specific questions and requests to the Settlement Administrator. The email address is included in the Notices and displayed on the Settlement Website.

Settlement P.O. Box

- 12. EisnerAmper maintains a designated P.O. Box for the administration of the Settlement: Meholic v. Seattle Arena Company Settlement, P.O. Box 5229, Baton Rouge, LA 70821. EisnerAmper monitors the Settlement P.O. Box for Settlement-related mail such as Claim Forms, objections, exclusion requests, and inquiries about the Settlement. EisnerAmper promptly handles all mail received at the Settlement P.O. Box.
- 13. As of January 2, 2025, EisnerAmper has received 12 pieces of administrative mail through the P.O. Box.

CLAIM FORM SUBMISSIONS

Overview

14. Settlement Class Members had the option of submitting Claims online or mailing the printed Claim Form to the Settlement Administrator. The online Claim Form feature was available on the Settlement Website beginning October 17, 2024. The online Claim Form requires Settlement Class Members to provide their preferred method of contact information, provide either (a) the card issuer and a portion of the card number used to validate against the eligible purchase transactions² or (b) information about their purchase history at Climate Pledge

² On September 11, 2024, Defendant provided the Settlement Class Data in order to validate claims.

Arena (including documentation, if available) for review, as well as a certification of the truthfulness of the information contained in the Claim Form. As part of the Claims Process, Settlement Class Members had the option to select their preferred payment method via check or digital payment, such as by Venmo, Zelle, Digital MasterCard³, or ACH.

Summary of Submitted Claims

15. As of January 2, 2025, EisnerAmper has received a total of 3,102 Claim submissions. EisnerAmper shall continue to intake and analyze Claims through the filing deadline of February 14, 2025, and provided updated claims information to the Court as requested by Class Counsel. Table 2 below provides summary statistics of Claim submissions and current dispositions.

- 17. The amended deadline for Class Members to object to the Settlement is January 17, 2025. To date, EisnerAmper has received zero (0) timely, valid objections.

CONCLUSION

- 18. In class action notice planning, execution, and analysis, we are guided by due process considerations under the United States Constitution, and by case law pertaining to the recognized notice standards under relevant Washington law and Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, Rule 23. This framework directs that the notice plan be optimized to reach the class and, in a settlement notice situation such as this, that the notice or notice plan itself did not limit knowledge of legal rights—nor the ability to exercise other options—to class members in any way. All of these requirements were met in this case.
- 19. It is my opinion, based on my expertise and experience and that of my team, that the methods of notice dissemination implemented by this Settlement, and the Court's Preliminary Approval Order, provided effective notice of the Settlement, provided the best notice that is practicable, adhered to Wash. Sup. Ct. Civ. R. 23 and Fed. R. Civ. P. 23, followed the guidance set forth in the Manual for Complex Litigation 4th Ed. and FJC guidance, and met the requirements of due process, including its "desire to actually inform" requirement.
- 20. EisnerAmper will provide a supplemental declaration to the Court prior to the Final Approval Hearing, which will provide updated settlement administration statistics.
